

WATER USAGE RESTRICTIONS *as of today and until further notice*

Due to technical problems and the ongoing drought and heat period in the foreseeable future, the SITSE have to take exceptional measures and ask you to abide by the rules and follow the recommendations listed below.

In order to be able to ensure a sufficient water supply for all users of the region, the SITSE ask you to avoid any waste of water and to reduce your consumption as much as possible. The communal fountains have already been turned off.

Watering of lawns and gardens, filling up or renewing the water of swimming pools or paddling pools of any type or size or of any other pond or fountain **is authorized:**

◆ **On even days** in the Communes of:
[Bogis-Bossey](#), [Chavannes-de-Bogis](#), [Chavannes-des-Bois](#), [Crassier](#) and [Founex](#)

◆ **On odd days** in the Communes of:
[Mies](#), [Tannay](#), [Commugny](#) and [Coppet](#)

It is generally recommended to:

- ◆ Water in the evenings and early mornings (i.e. between 8 and 10 pm and 5 and 7 am);
- ◆ Water manually by can or by hose;
- ◆ Avoid automatic watering;
- ◆ Avoid cleaning of drive- and walkways, parkings, courtyards, cars or any objects with water;
- ◆ Take showers rather than baths;
- ◆ Avoid leaving the taps open or leaking and the water running;
- ◆ Reduce your personal water consumption as much as possible.
